Ethical Sourcing Practices

Objective: To ensure that all goods and services procured by The Safety Lab are sourced responsibly, reflecting our values of transparency and adherence to labour and human rights standards.

Policy Commitments:

- Prioritise working with suppliers who align with ethical practices.
- Avoid sourcing from entities associated with child labour or forced labour.
- Maintain an open dialogue with suppliers to promote ethical improvements.

Implementation Measures:

- Clearly communicate expectations to suppliers.
- Monitor supplier compliance periodically through reviews.
- Provide a mechanism for reporting concerns within the supply chain.

Sustainability

Objective: To embed sustainability into The Safety Lab's operations, reducing environmental impact while supporting our clients' goals.

Ethical Conduct

Anti-Bribery
